

## Voting Location Information for Candidates

### Voting location

Includes any place within 100m of the voting location property designated by the clerk.

### No election campaign material

No person shall display a candidate's election campaign material or literature within a voting location.

### Prohibition

While a voter is in a voting location, no person shall attempt, directly or indirectly, to influence how a voter votes. **Please make note of the following:**

Electioneering is the act of campaigning or attempting to solicit votes and **is not allowed** within 100m of the voting location property.

Electioneering includes but is not limited to the following:

- Speaking to a voter on the subject of marking their ballot.
- Displaying any sign, sticker, button, clothing or advertisement that in any way conveys information pertaining to candidates or the voting process.
- Distributing any signs, literature, pamphlets, or notes that in any way conveys information to voters on who they should vote for.
- Photographing, videotaping, or in any way recording someone voting or entering or exiting a voting location.

Photographs by accredited media may not include the images of identifiable individuals.

Election officials will ask candidates or their scrutineers to leave the property if electioneering occurs.

**York Region police Services have been notified of the dates and voting locations for the Advance Vote and Election Day and will be dispatched as necessary.**
