



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT PROXY VOTING

MUNICIPAL ELECTION DAY IN THE CITY OF VAUGHAN IS MONDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2010

WHAT IS A PROXY VOTE?

A Proxy Vote allows any qualified elector who is on the Voters' List to appoint another qualified elector who is also on the Voters' List in the same municipality to vote on his/her behalf. You can vote by Proxy if, for any reason you are unable to vote during Advance Vote Week or on Election Day.

HOW DO I ARRANGE FOR PROXY VOTING?

The person you appoint to act as your voting proxy must complete his/her portion of the *Appointment of Voting Proxy* form and present it **in person** to the Clerk's Department, 2141 Major Mackenzie Drive. The form must be certified by the City Clerk's office and is to be taken to the voting place by the voter appointed. The City Clerk's Department will be open Monday to Friday to receive and certify the Appointment of Voting Proxy forms during the following times:

Monday to Friday September 13 to October 22, 2010	8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
During weekday Advance Vote: Monday, October 4 to Friday October 8, 2010	8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
During the holiday weekend Advance Vote: Saturday, October 9 and Sunday, October 10, 2010	12 Noon to 5 p.m.
Election Day, Monday, October 25, 2010	8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
